One (1) signed original and seven (7) copies of the proposal, which shall include the application and budget forms along with all documentation listed on the checklist and listed below, will be received in the office of Gulf Coast Community Foundation until Friday, November 6, 2009, at 4:00pm, CST. Electronic submissions will not be accepted. Presentation of the project to the Board of Directors and/or a designated committee of the Gulf Coast Community Foundation may be required. Please submit a proposal for each project, program and/or service. There is no limit of proposal submissions.

- **No proceeds from Grant shall be used to pay any overhead and/or indirect costs of grantee, sub-grantees and/or partners;**
- **Proceeds from Grant shall be used for direct salaries, materials and/or durables related to execution of proposed project, program, and/or service;**
- **Priority will be given to those proposals with leveraged funds and/or collaborations with other community-based organizations;**
- **Minimum award per project: \$20,000.00;**
- **Maximum award per project: \$50,000.00.**

The Grant Request Proposal must include, but not limited to:

- Program Mission Statement;
- Measurable goals to achieve and benefits desired;
- Current market conditions and evaluation as related to the proposed project;
- Detailed description of the project requiring funding, including how the project will address solutions to meet needs created by Hurricane Katrina;
- Project timeline;
- Source of funding for staff and overhead associated with the project; and
- Proforma detailing how the project performs financially, including all sources and uses of project funds.
